- Board Chair Bohm re-affirmed the declaration for a County State of Emergency on Thursday , March 19th
- Dr. Mercantante issued a Public Health Emergency on Sunday, March 15<sup>th</sup>
- St Clair County EOC fully activated at 0800 on Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>
- St. Clair County Health Dept ECC fully activated on Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>
- Currently working with the hospital systems to create new testing system community wide to manage PPE shortages with need for testing.
- Please be patient with internet bandwidth – EOC was made aware of remarkable impacts to global data usage today and expect that to continue through this response.
