

## **Qualifications**

- Must be 16 years of age or older.
- If 18 years of age or older you Must be a registered voter in the State of Michigan
- Must be complete and file an Election Inspector Application. The applicant must list a political party affiliation (not independent) on the application.
- Must attend a training session prior to working as an election inspector.
- Must have no felony or election fraud convictions.

## **Precinct Election Inspector Boards**

- Inspectors are appointed from those who have properly completed and filed an application with the Charter Township of China and have attended a training session.
- An inspector cannot be a candidate, challenger or member of the Board of Canvassers.
- A member of a candidate's immediate family cannot serve as an election inspector.

## **Election Day Requirements**

- The polling place must be open for voting between 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- A majority of the board must be in attendance at the polling place at all times during the election.
- Election Inspectors must report for work at the time set by the Charter Township of Chinas Clerk, usually 6 a.m.
- After the polls close at 8:00 p.m., election inspectors must prepare the election materials and supplies and equipment must also be stored before leaving the polling place.

## **Current Pay Rate**

- Inspectors are paid \$10 an hour for Election Day and additional salary for each training session attended.
- Chairperson receives \$11 an hour for Election Day and additional salary for each training session attended.
